DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY YOUTH RED CROSS UNIT OF OUR COLLEGE IN THIS YEAR:

WORLD RED CROSS DAY

The tradition of celebration of the World Red Cross Day on May 8th, this year was observed by paying tribute to the volunteers for their unprecedented contribution to the people in need. A seminar was held at the D. K. N. College on the theme, 'On the site of Humanity' and in this seminar the experienced members of the college commended the volunteers for their selfless efforts. Since the inception of Red Cross, voluntary action has been its quintessence. Volunteering, serves as a means in helping the society to bridge the gap between the crisis and the crisis management.

INDUCTION MEETING

An induction meeting was organised by the YRC unit of the college in the month of September 2024 to make aware of the students about the principles of Red Cross and role of a YRC. YRC counsellor shared with the volunteers about their role and responsibility as a YRC volunteer.

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

The YRC unit of the college organized Blood Donation camp and Blood grouping camp in the college premises on dt. 10.12.2024 and collected 62 units of blood which was a great contribution to the society. The camp was inaugurated by Dr. Binayak Prusty, Director CRBB, Cuttack with Mr. Markandeswr Mohapatra, Principal of the College.

Central Red Cross Blood Bank, Cuttack provided all cooperation for organizing the camp.

RED RIBBON CLUB

With the financial support of OSACS a RRC was formed with involving 30 volunteers to spread the awareness on HIV & AIDS among the college students and general public of adopted village. A series of programmes were organised such as.

- Peer Educator training
- Seminar on awareness on HIV & AIDS
- Different competitions on the subject among the college students
- Observance of World AIDS Day
- Observance of National Youth Day
- Organisation of Blood Donation Camp

OBSERVANCE OF WORLD AIDS DAY

As one part of the programme of Red Ribbon Club the world AIDS Day was observed by YRC this year with several activities.

QUIZ COMPETITION: A quiz competition was organized among the students. A number of 30 questions were asked by quiz master Mr U.R.Mohanty and prizes were awarded to the winners on the spot. The questions set for quiz were based on AIDS.

SEMINAR: On the same day a seminar on AIDS was organized in the premises of the college which was inaugurated by Mrs. Sabitri Mohapatra, Principal of the college. Hon'ble speakers delivered speech on cause, effects and methods of prevention of AIDS and HIV and shared with participants regarding cause & prevention of AIDS. Mr. Gopal Krishna Mishra, Secretary General, ANTARDRUSTI shared with the participants about the provisions available in District counseling centers. The meeting was coordinated by Mr. G. K. Mishra, YRC Counselor of the college.

PLANTATION DRIVE:

A plantation in the premises of the College was organized on the same day just after the workshop. Medicinal plants were planted in the botanical garden of the college and a number of students were selected for the after care of the plants. The best grown plants will be awarded in the annual function of the college. A YRC garden was also inaugurated by the Principal in front of the YRC office .

FIRST AID TRAINING

The Youth Red Cross of DKN College likely conducted first aid training programs for its members and students, focusing on basic medical care and emergency response techniques. These sessions might have covered topics such as wound management, CPR, and fracture stabilization, equipping participants with essential life-saving skills.

DISASTER MANAGEMENT TRAINING

Disaster management training sessions were probably organized to educate students on disaster preparedness, response, and mitigation strategies. These sessions might have included topics like emergency planning, evacuation procedures, and search and rescue operations, enabling students to respond effectively in crisis situations ^{1 2}.

NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

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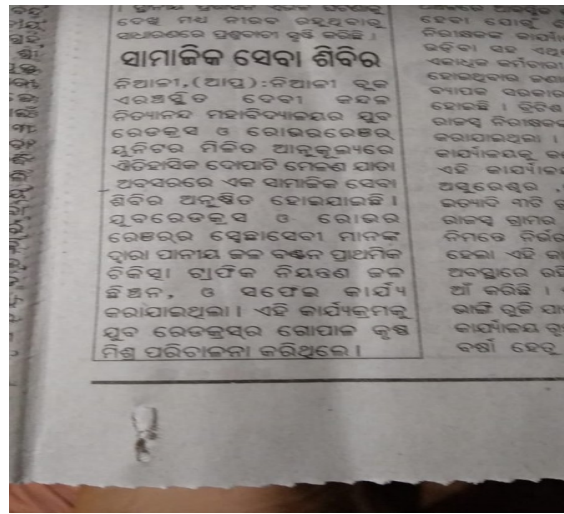
